

# Great Expectations Book Work

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## TASK ONE: BOOK TITLES

Book Titles:

Some authors use chapters to give an overview of a chapter's content or to point toward a significant incident or theme. Sometimes a chapter title is taken directly from the dialogue or descriptions in the story. For example, chapter one of *Great Expectations* could have been titled "My Earliest Memory" or "The Horrible Young Man."

Skim through chapters 1-13, and create chapter titles based on what you have read, similar to the examples.

## TASK TWO: DIARY ENTRIES

1. Review chapter 8
2. Assume the persona of Pip, and write a diary entry about his feelings after his first visit to the Satis house. Use quotes from the chapter to make his descriptions of the events and conversations more vivid.
3. Then, assume Estella's persona, and write an entry in her diary about the same visit. Again, use descriptions and quotes from the book to support her feelings.
