

Sorting and Ordering “Questions to Prompt” Questions



Check points:

- 1) Do the questions relate to your quotations? (1-4 for quotation #1 and 5-8 for quotation #2)
- 2) Does each question ask about a new idea **AND** encourage deeper thought? (No repetition, and no low-level thinking.)
- 3) Does each question relate to either the rhetorical device in question and/or the tone developed?
- 4) Is there at least **ONE** question per quotation that relates directly to tone?
- 5) Is there at least **ONE** question per quotation that relates directly to the purpose?
- 6) Decide on the order of the questions—if you were answering each in paragraph form, what order would you answer/discuss them?
- 7) Once all check-points have been reached, share out with your group.

HW tonight is to create one chunk (TS, SM (basic summary of speech), CX, CD (blended), CMx3. Use your organized questions to help guide this process.
